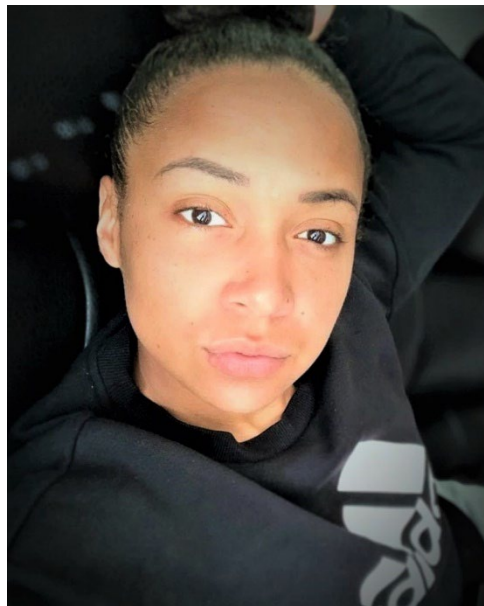




U.S. Army CID Offers a Reward up to **\$50,000.00**



The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division (CID) is offering a reward for credible information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Staff Sgt. Jessica Ann Mitchell. CID and the San Antonio Police Department are asking for the public's help in identifying suspects and/or witnesses of her murder. Jessica was shot to death with a high-powered rifle in her vehicle on IH-10 near Vance Jackson Road, San Antonio, TX. A vehicle of interest was seen traveling southbound on IH-10 behind Jessica's white Dodge Charger on IH-10 about 2:08 a.m. on 1 Jan 2021.
